

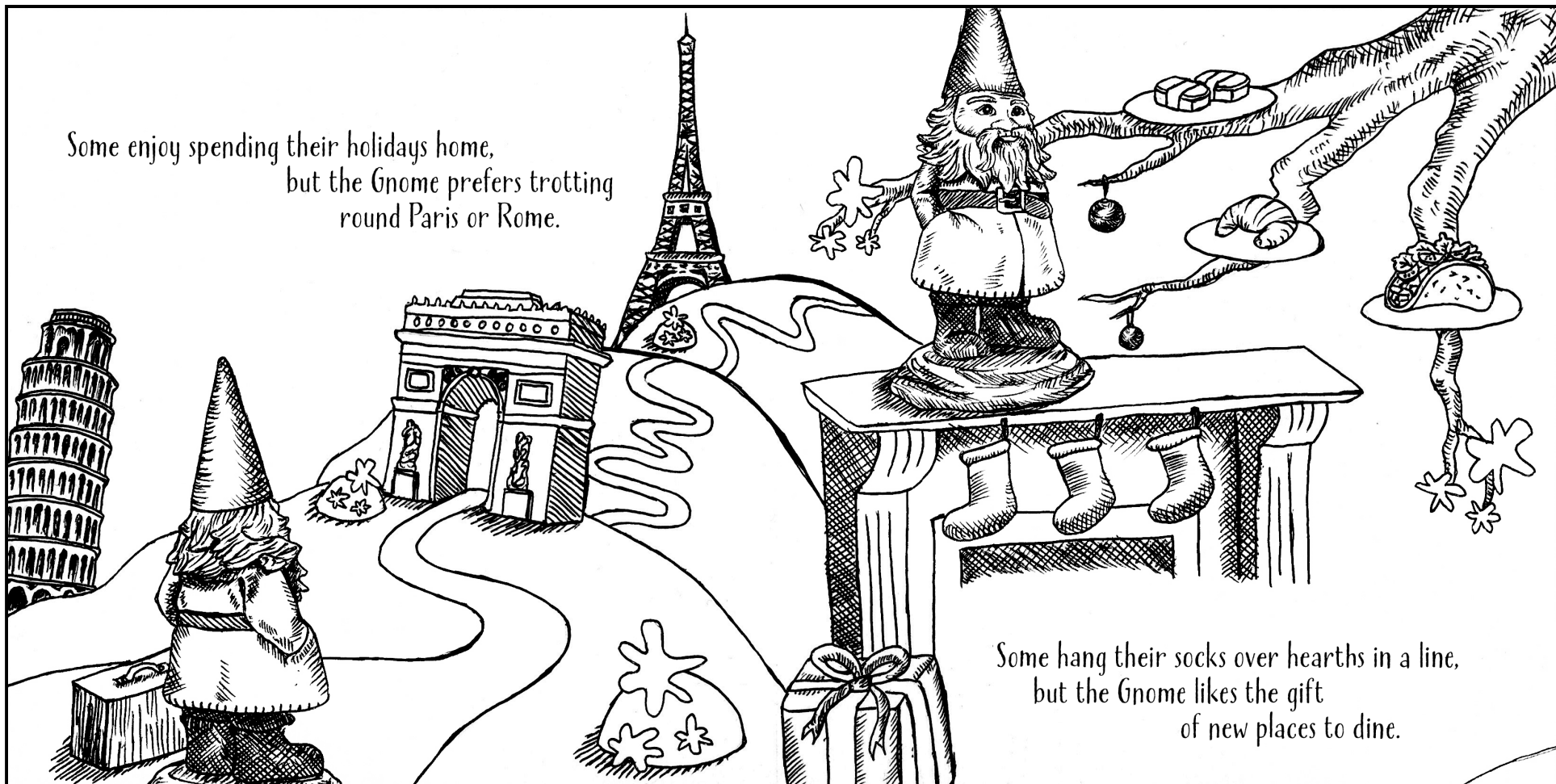

A Roaming Gnome Holiday



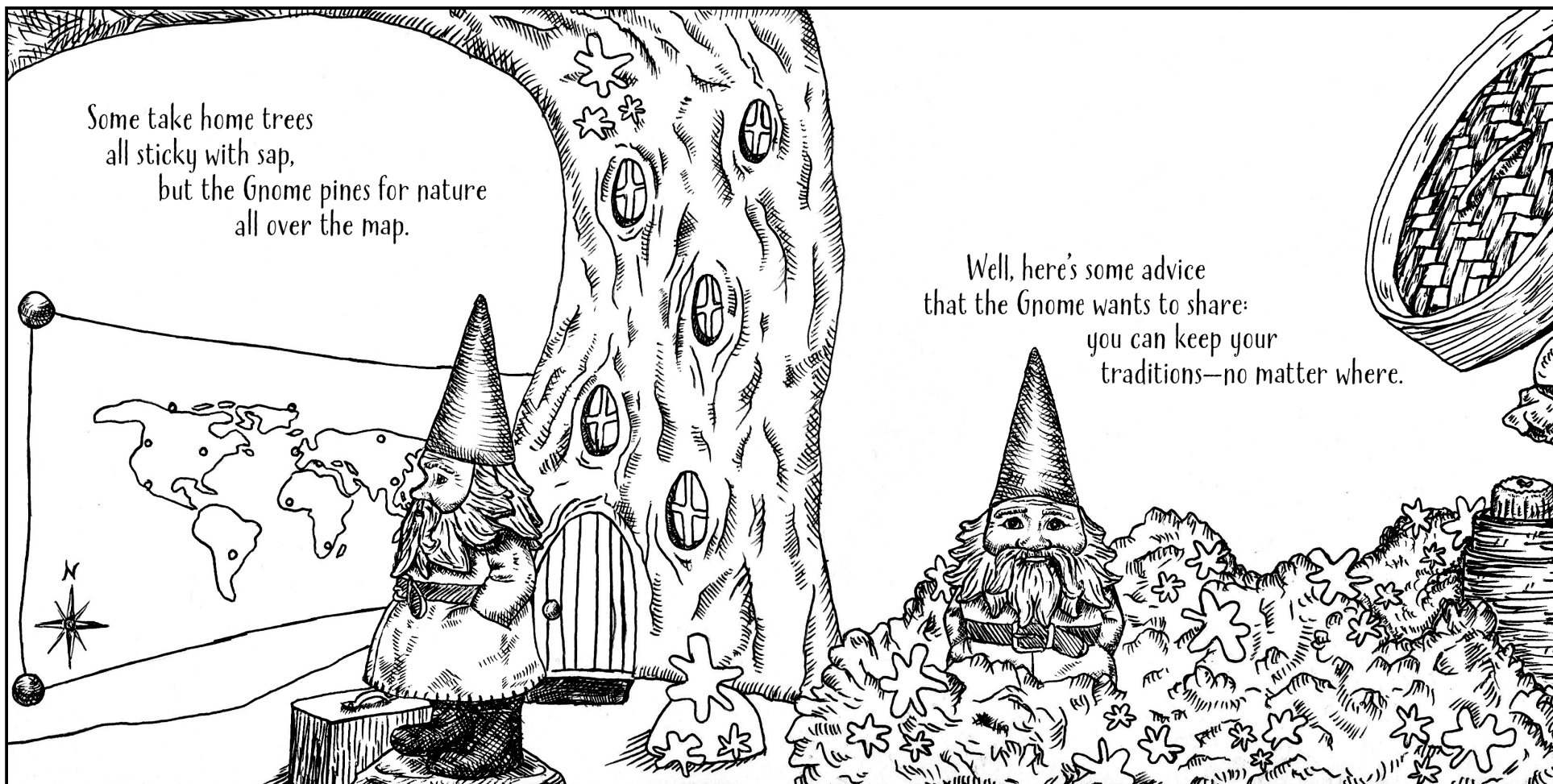
Some enjoy spending their holidays home,

round Paris or Rome.

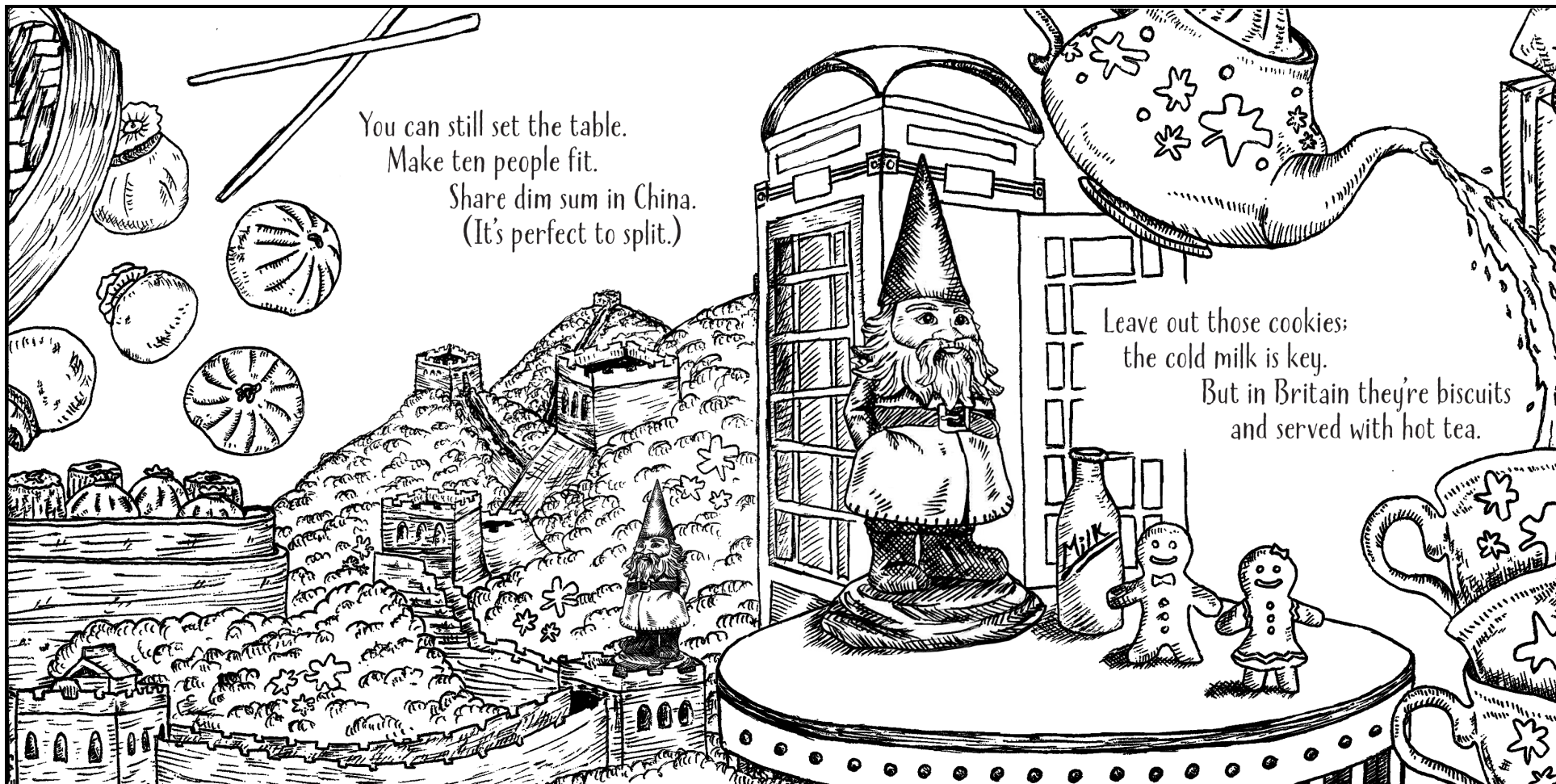


Some hang their socks over hearths in a line,

all over the map.

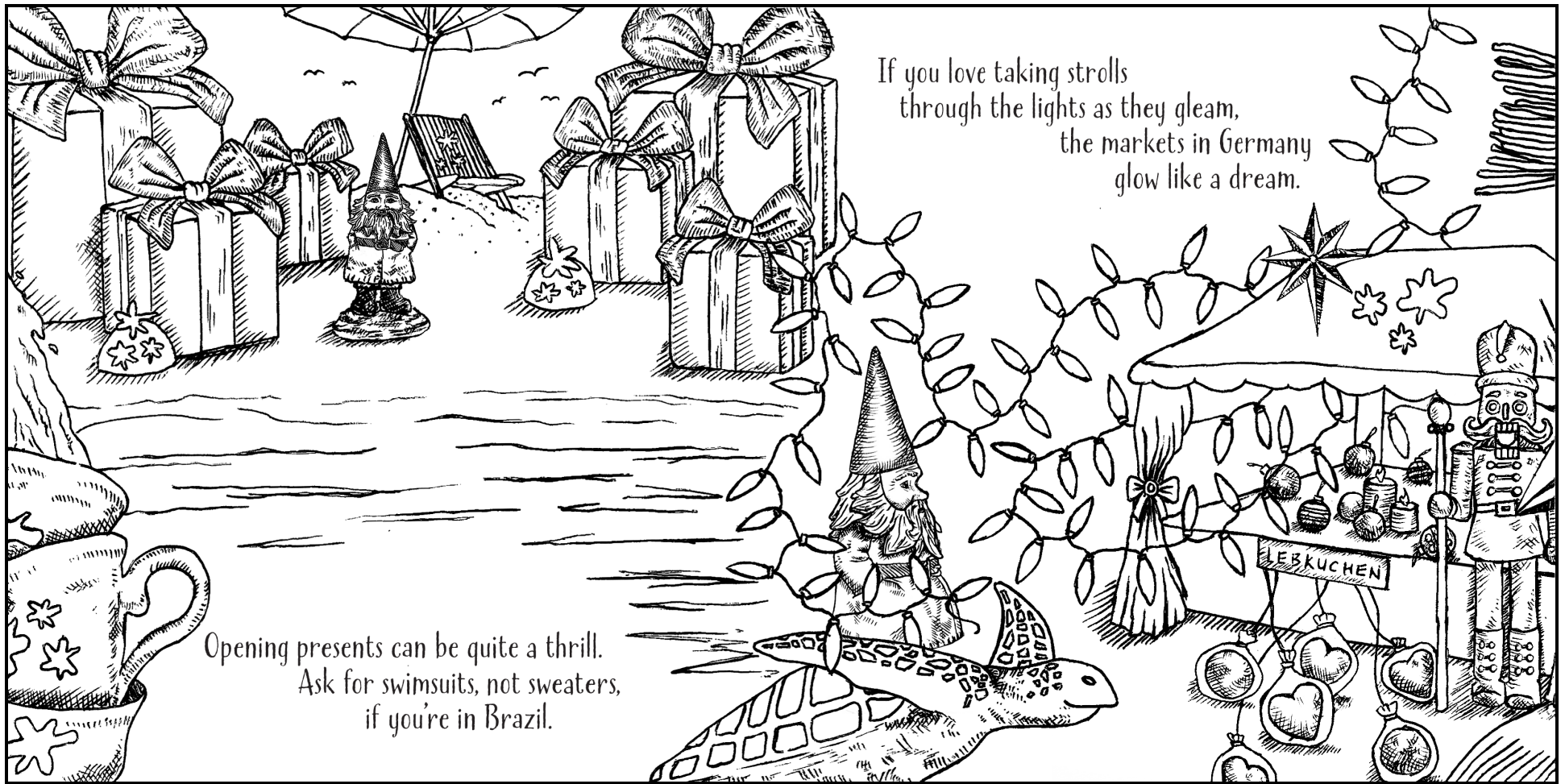
Well, here's some advice
